## DigiComp Update – August 2015

In the July 2015 DigiComp Planning Project update, we addressed the need for training for both internal and external users of the new system. Possible training options for internal users were given, and now we will explain possible training options for all external stakeholders who will be using our system. Examples of external stakeholders are legal staff, insurance carriers, employers and self-insureds.

Training options include:

- User manuals (Step-by-step written instructions)
- Webinars
- Self-help videos
- Regional training

In order to ease the transition from primarily paper reporting of information to an electronic format, and demonstrate general navigation of the new system, we will provide various training options. The user manuals will be on our website, and could potentially be a series of user manuals for the different types of users. Another training option is using webinars and self-help videos to provide a visual equivalent of those written user manuals. The last training option is to have regional on-site training of external stakeholders; the scope and agenda of the training will be determined at a later date. All information regarding external stakeholder training will be available on our website as the project progresses.

The DigiComp Team will continue to provide monthly updates of the status of our project, and details regarding the new system. The next topic we will address is dashboards, which will include taking a look at automated workflows and its impact on business processes.
