Workplace posters are required, but FREE

Topeka — The Kansas Department of Labor provides several posters that Kansas employers are required to display in their workplace. These posters are provided free of charge to Kansas businesses. Additionally, both the federal and state posters can be downloaded from the Internet and printed out by employers for posting where their employees can read them.

"We understand that employers receive mailings or phone calls seeking to sell these posters to businesses. KDOL is pleased to provide this free service to Kansas employers," said Jim Garner, Kansas Secretary of Labor. "There are no required posters – state or federal – that must be purchased."
