

After reviewing the entire record and having considered the arguments and briefs of the parties, the Appeals Board finds that the Award by the Administrative Law Judge should be affirmed.

The Appeals Board adopts the findings, conclusions, and orders of the Administrative Law Judge as its own as if specifically set forth herein. The permanent disability resulting from claimant's overuse syndrome or cumulative trauma injury is limited to the right upper extremity. The Appeals Board finds that claimant has not proven entitlement to a disability award based upon a whole body impairment. Accordingly, the claimant is limited to a disability based upon a scheduled injury pursuant to K.S.A. 44-510d.

The Appeals Board also agrees with the conclusion by the Administrative Law Judge that no further medical treatment is necessary at this time. Claimant is entitled to future medical only upon proper application to and approval by the Director.

AWARD

WHEREFORE, it is the finding, decision, and order of the Appeals Board that the Award entered by Administrative Law Judge Robert H. Foerschler dated July 16, 1996 should be, and is hereby, affirmed.
