

As the Order of the Administrative Law Judge appears to deal directly with the providing of medical care for the claimant, the issue raised by the respondent can neither fall under the umbrella of K.S.A. 44-534a nor under K.S.A. 44-551. As such, the Appeals Board does not have jurisdiction to consider this matter and the Order of Administrative Law Judge Shannon S. Krysl, dated September 14, 1995, remains in full force and effect.

WHEREFORE, it is the finding, decision, and order of the Appeals Board that the Order of Administrative Law Judge Shannon S. Krysl, dated September 14, 1995, remains in full force and effect and the appeal of the respondent in this matter, is hereby dismissed.
