Notice of Right to Seek Judicial Review

This is a final order issued by the Public Employee Relations Board pursuant to K.S.A. 77-527. This order is subject to review by the district court in accordance with the Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of State Agency Actions (K.S.A. 77-601 et seq.)

Unless a motion for reconsideration is filed pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, a petition for judicial review must be filed with the appropriate district court within 30 days after the Final Order is served on the parties. Since this Final Order is being served upon the parties by mail, the parties are allowed a total of 33 days from the date on the certificate of mailing below to file their petition for judicial review in the appropriate district court. See K.S.A. 77-613 (b) and (e).

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-527 (j), K.S.A. 77-613 (e), and K.S.A. 77-615 (a), any party seeking judicial review must serve a copy of its petition upon the Board's designated agent at the following address:
