
UNIT: INCLUDE: All persons employed by the Kansas Highway Patrol in the permanent civil service classification of Trooper.

EXCLUDE: All other employees

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall meet and confer with the Kansas State Troopers Association.
