KDOL provides free posters to Kansas employers

TOPEKA – Kansas employers are required by state and federal law to display several posters in their workplace and the Kansas Department of Labor provides those posters free of charge. They are available at www.dol.ks.gov.

“Customer service is a key to the success and mission of the Department of Labor, and as part of that, we want to be sure Kansas employers have the resources they need to meet federal and state requirements,” said Jim Garner, Secretary of the Kansas Department of Labor. “Employers often get solicitations to purchase these required posters. The required state posters are about child labor, unemployment insurance, workers compensation and equal opportunity in employment.
