

DigiComp Update – April 2016

The legal assistants in Lenexa began the Doodle testing pilot for scheduling of regular hearings on January 1, 2016, and will continue to do so until June 30, 2016. Doodle is a scheduling tool that allows multiple parties to agree upon a date for meetings by answering a poll, which has a series of dates and times available. The Doodle Poll is created on www.doodle.com by one of the parties, who will choose the dates and times and select the other attendees. An internal user manual was provided to staff and an email with the information regarding how to use Doodle is being sent to any external users prior to the Doodle poll being sent. Doodle is currently only used for scheduling of regular hearings. Preliminary hearings, and prehearing settlement conferences, etc., are still scheduled via email or phone. Requests for regular hearings have the lowest volume out of the different types of hearing requests. Those scheduling a regular hearing are given the option to use Doodle. No one is required to use Doodle for scheduling. The testers have kept a record of those requesting regular hearings, whether or not they opted to use Doodle, and feedback from those that did use Doodle.
