Free Workplace Posters – Provided by the Kansas Department of Labor

Topeka — Federal and Kansas State law requires that certain posters be displayed in the work place. The Kansas Department of Labor (KDOL) provides these posters free of charge to Kansas businesses. Both federal and state posters can be requested by mail, phone, or can be downloaded from the Internet and printed out by employers for posting where their employees can read them.

"Employers should never have to pay for state or federal required workplace posters," said Jim Garner, Kansas Secretary of Labor. "KDOL is pleased to provide Kansas businesses with this free service."

KDOL currently provides the Kansas Child Labor, Unemployment Insurance and Workers Compensation posters at no cost to Kansas employers.
