Presentation's will feature *Independent Medical Examination (IME) and Back Rating, Sixth Edition, New Approaches to Complex Back Surgery, Online System for Claims Administration and Research/Regulation (OSCAR) Basics, Changes in Medicare and Medicaid Liens, Pain Management and Depression and Anxiety Following a Work Injury*. Attendees will also learn about Workers Compensation Computation Class, Workers Compensation Basics and Advanced Workers Compensation.
