All Required State Posters Available for Download FREE Of Charge

TOPEKA, Kan. – Kansas employers are required by state and federal law to display certain posters in the workplace where they can be viewed by employees. All state posters are available for download **FREE** of charge through the Kansas Department of Labor (KDOL). They are found online at <http://www.dol.ks.gov/Laws/Posters.aspx>

"We want to ensure Kansas employers have all the resources they need to meet federal and state requirements," said Lana Gordon, KDOL Secretary. "Employers may get solicitations to purchase these required posters, but they need to know there are no-cost options available through our website. As a customer service, we are pleased to offer this essential information FREE of charge."

The required state posters include information on the Kansas Indoor Clean Air Act, unemployment insurance, workers compensation, child labor laws and the equal opportunity in employment guidelines. KDOL also provides links or contact information for the required federal posters. Required federal posters may vary by business.
