

How to Submit the Identity Verification Form for Law Enforcement Officers



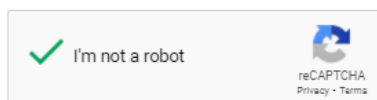
Law enforcement officers (LEO) whose office has opted-in to the KDOL claimant identity verification (IDV) process can submit any completed IDV forms on the LEO Portal.

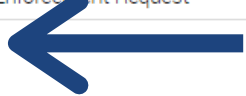


Click on the reCAPTCHA to verify and enter your LEO certification number. Then click "Submit".
