



Job Refusal Forms

Employers are now able to submit information regarding job offers/refusals online. When an employer offers work to a former employee or an applicant who they suspect is receiving unemployment benefits, they should immediately access our website at KansasEmployer.gov and click on the *Job Refusal Form* link.

Claimants receiving unemployment benefits are required to search for work. If they refuse a job offer, this may affect their eligibility.

After completing and submitting the information, a KDOL employee will handle the issue and adjudicate it in a timely manner. This will lessen the time spent by the employer in contacting KDOL for a paper form and the issue will be handled more quickly.

Coming Soon: SIDES and SIDES E-Response

The new State Information Data Exchange System (SIDES) and SIDES E-Response will allow companies to electronically respond to UI information requests from KDOL. This will eliminate delays caused by mailing the documents. These programs are scheduled for full release sometime in Second Quarter 2012.

SIDES and SIDES E-Response are secure and free of charge. They will also help your company simplify and streamline responses to UI information requests by offering the following benefits:

- Ensures accurate information exchanges
- Reduces administrative costs
- Saves time
- Minimizes UI rates
- Addresses two of the largest causes of UI overpayments
