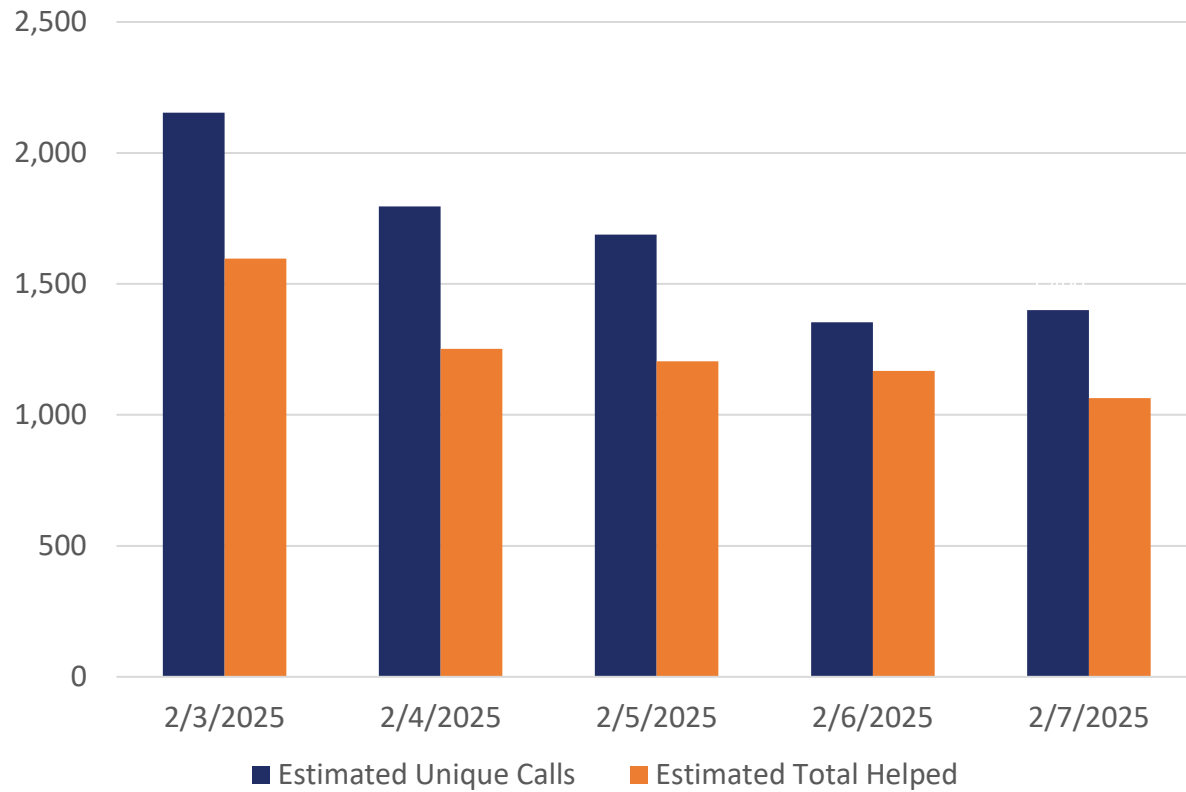

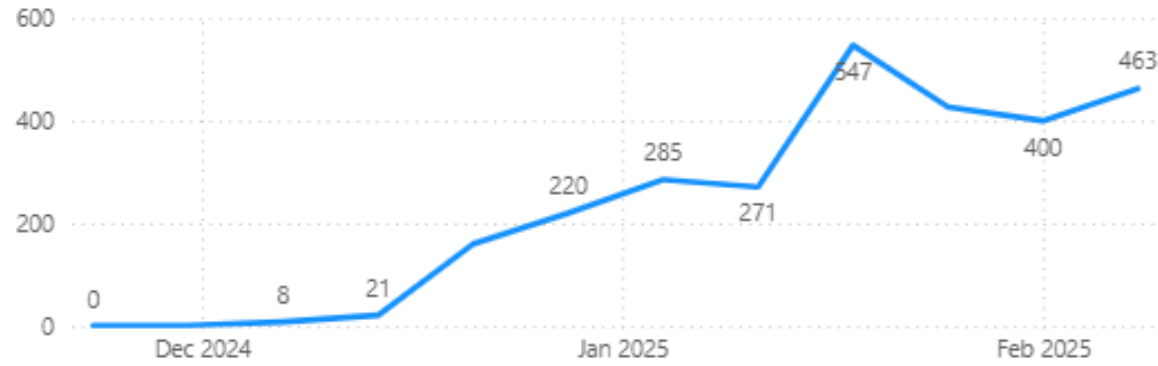
- State offices closed for Inclement Weather on February 12, 2025

## Other

- As of February 10, 2025, approximately 94% of employers have filed a quarterly wage report (QWR).
- How many negative rated employers took advantage of the write off provision and what was the total amount written off?
  - The deadline to postmark a voluntary contribution was February 4, 2025. We will provide preliminary numbers at end of February and official numbers at end of Q1 2025.
  - 17 Employers have voluntarily elected to take advantage of the extra timeline that HB2570 has provided.
  - No negative rated employers have taken advantage. A few have requested a write-off because that option benefits them more than any voluntary contribution would benefit them.
- An update on participation in the Shared Work program will be provided in the February 28, 2025, report.

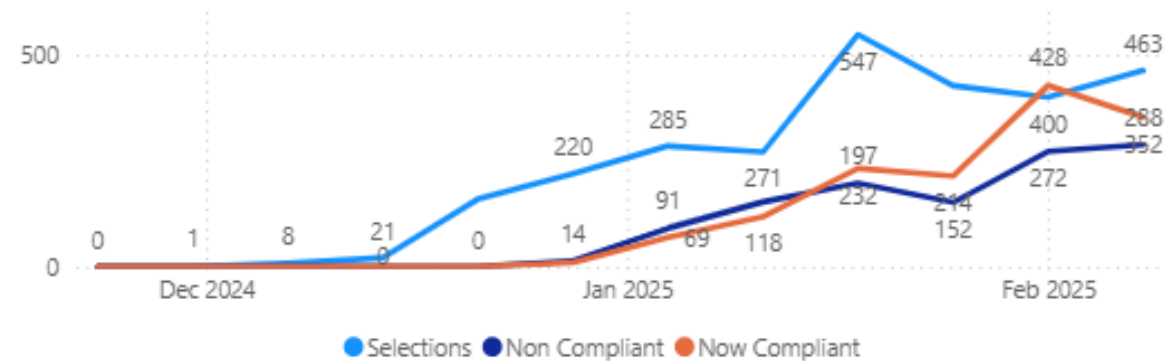

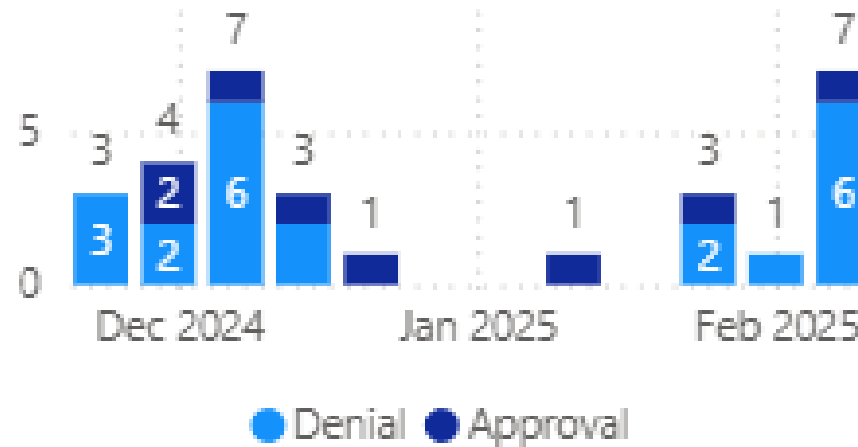



 This may cause a delay in Unemployment Insurance payments.




