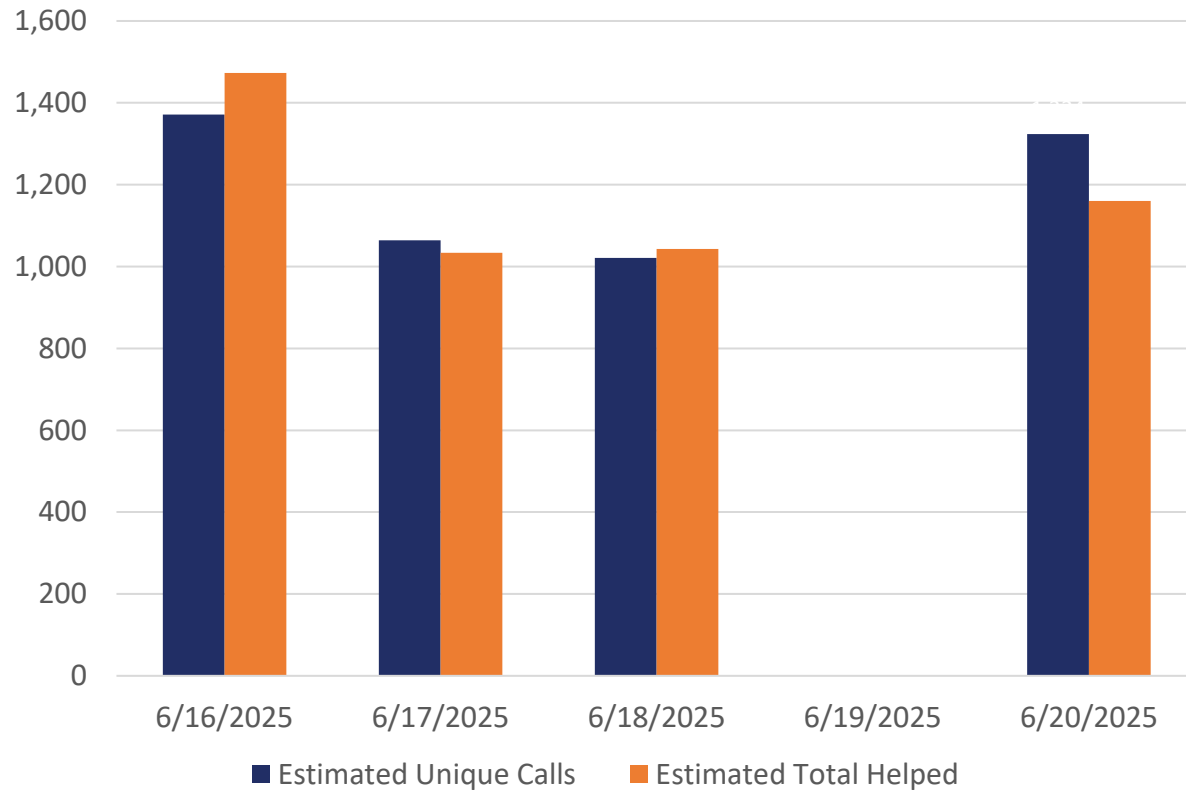

System Disruptions

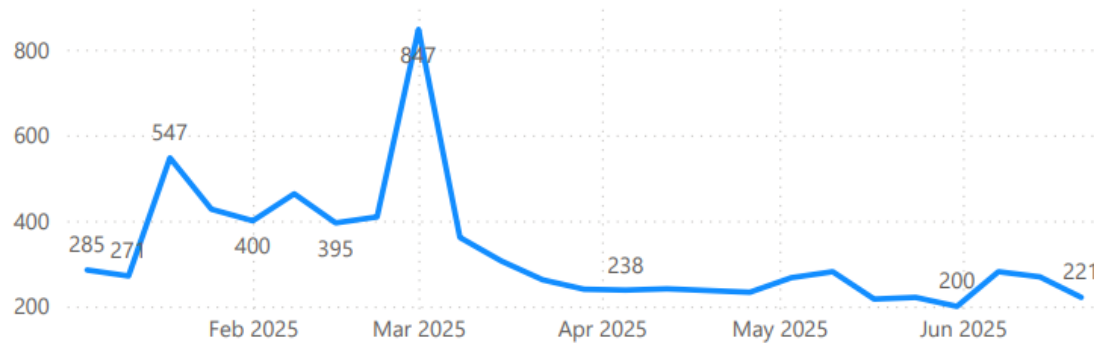
- June 17-23: Claimants unable to self-service filing of new claims due to a service failure after server update, resolved via service restart. New claims were being filed through the Contact Center. Corrective actions include better patch coordination, automation, and post-update validation.
- June 18: Admin and claimant logins failed due to silent breakdown in security service communication post-reboot, issue resolved very shortly after manual restart. Root cause addressed through improved monitoring and recovery processes.

Other

- June 26: KDOL announced the cancellation of the USDOL UI Integrity and Fraud Prevention Grant. Secretary Shultz issued a formal letter urging reconsideration.
- Programming for the Implementation Plan: SB125 Proviso – Amendment to K.S.A. 44-703 is in progress to be effective July 1. Kansas UI Benefit Limits Update: For new claims filed between July 1, 2025, and June 30, 2026, weekly benefit amounts will range from \$159 to \$637.
- For calendar year 2026, the Kansas taxable wage base for employers will be CY 2026 Taxable Wage Base of \$15,100.
- Government Affairs Director, Julie Menghini, is retiring on June 30. Deputy Secretary, Amy Selm, will be the interim in the transition period.

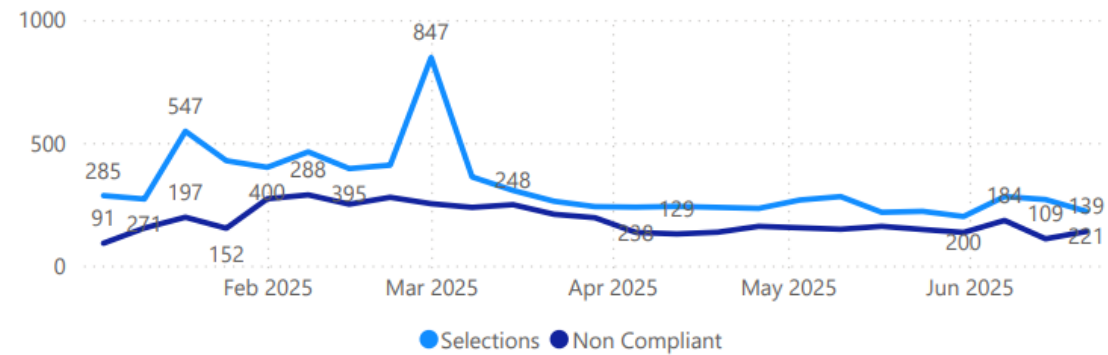

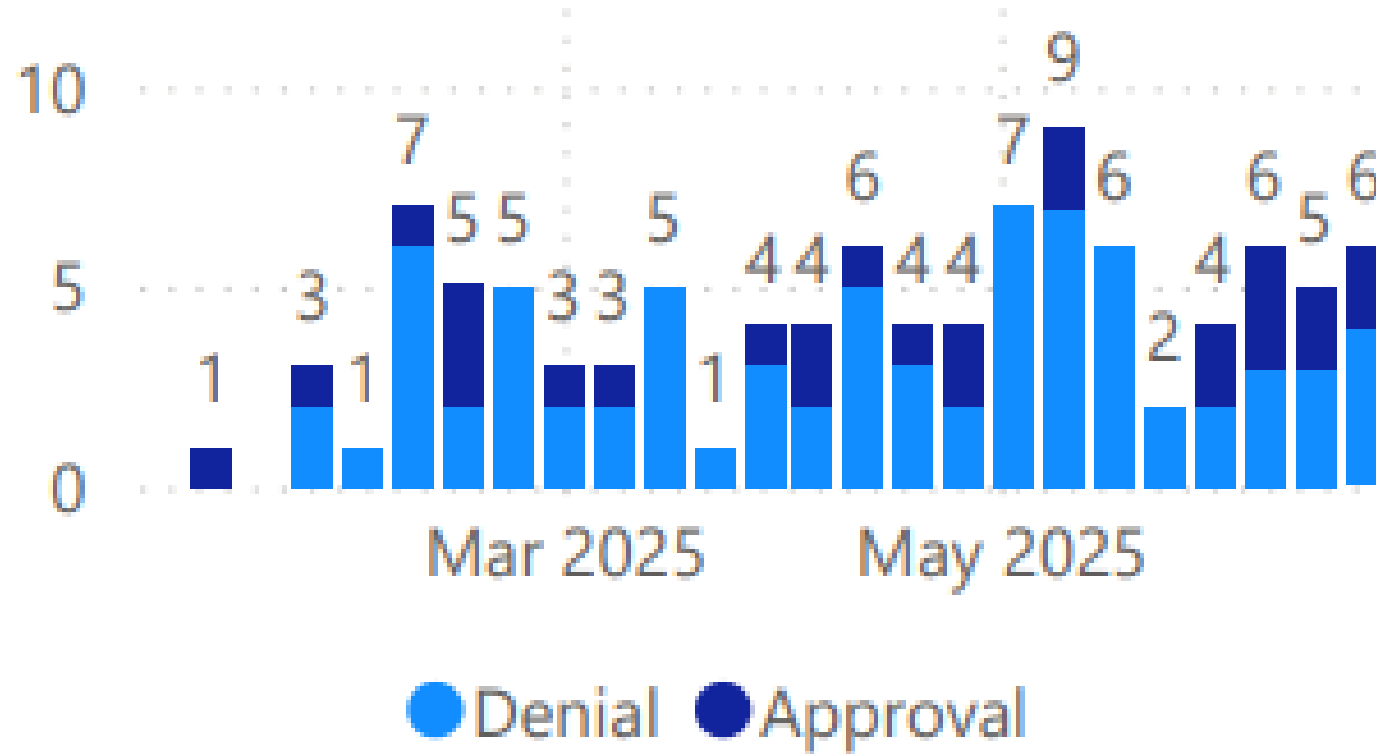

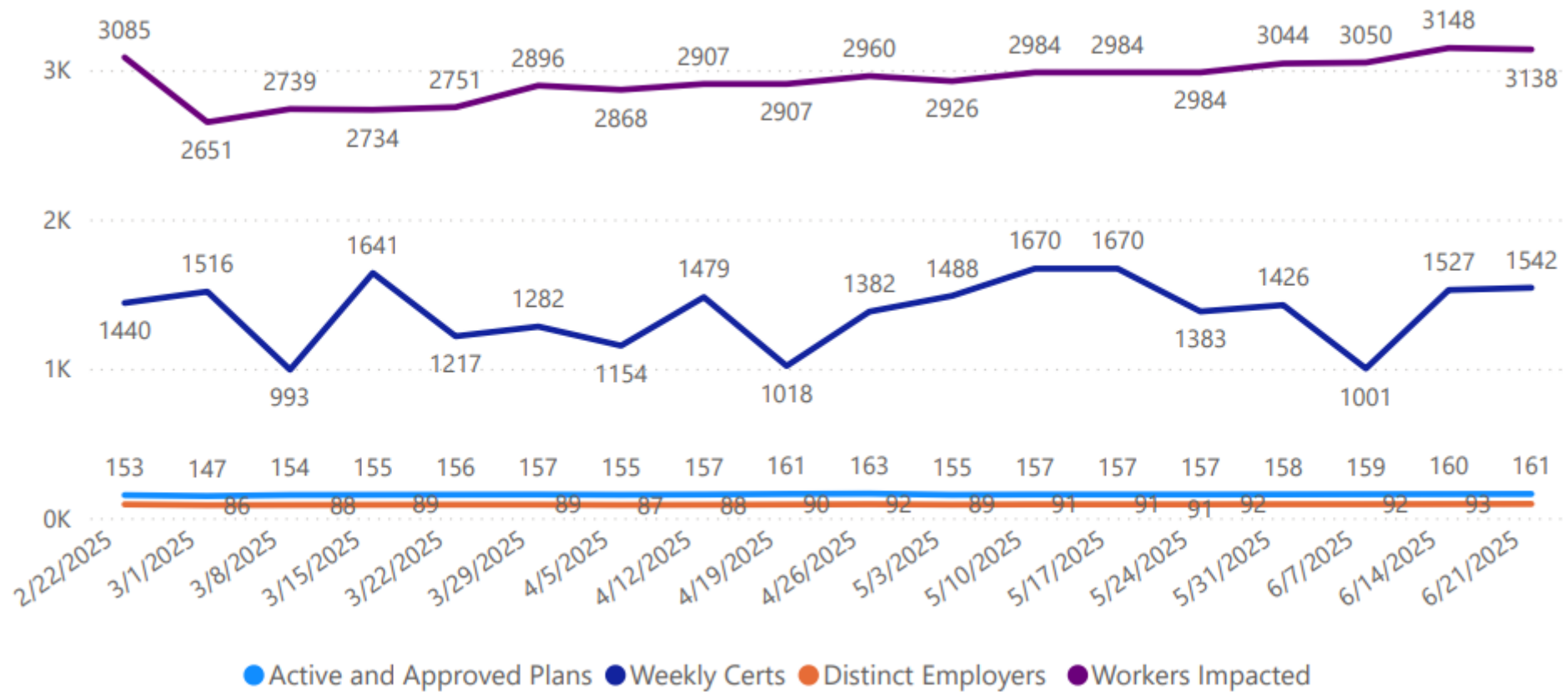

Shared Work Program Toolkit

Shared Work can help employers:

- Avoid layoffs
- Retain experienced employees
- Reduce the impact of business downturns
- Increase productivity


Business Eligibility Requirements

As determined by the Shared Work Program, an employer must:

- Have employees who are eligible for unemployment benefits
- Have a business that is not a seasonal business
- Have a business that is not a franchise or a subsidiary of another business
- Have employees who are not on a leave of absence
- Have employees who are not on a temporary assignment
- Have employees who are not on a contract assignment
