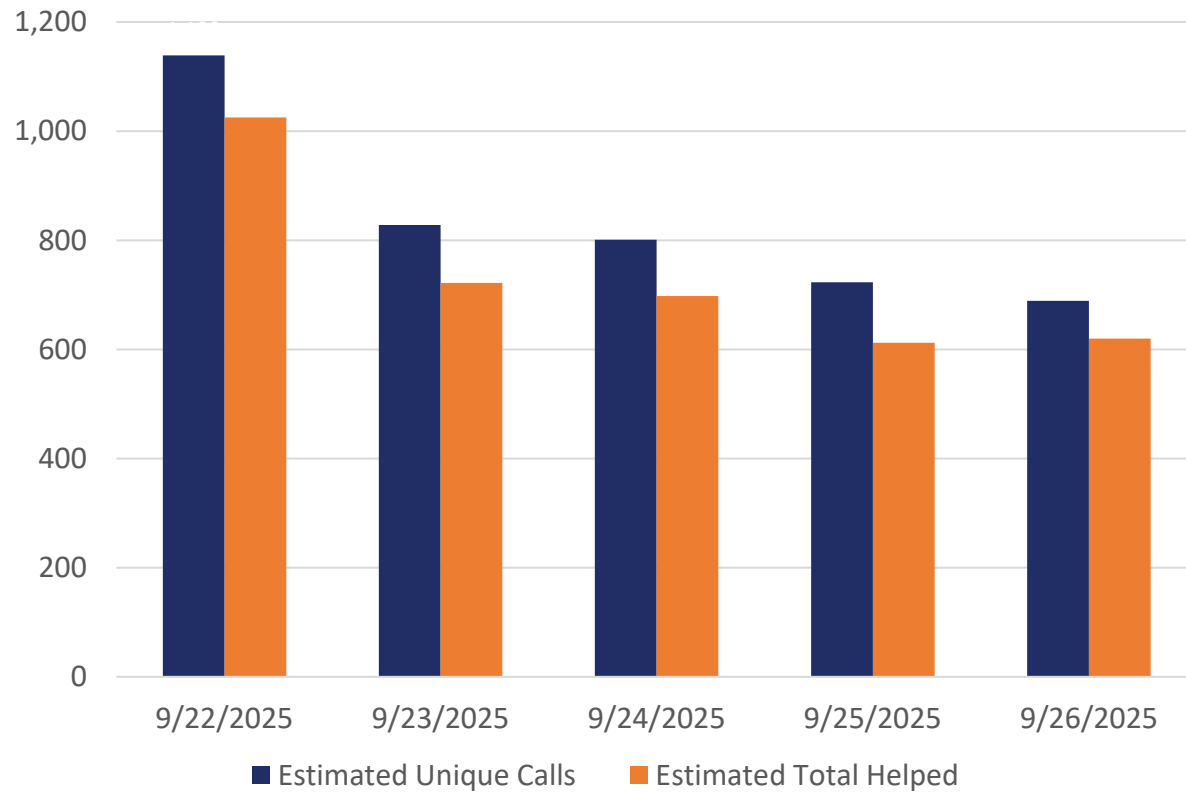

System Disruptions

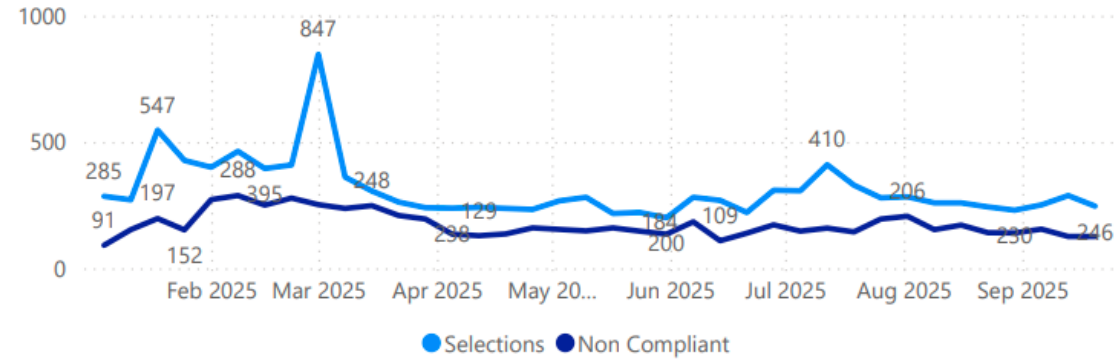

- September 24: A scheduled deployment to the UI claimant and employer portal was successfully completed. As planned, the system was offline from 8:00 PM to 10:30 PM during the update.

Other

- KDOL Unemployment Insurance operations are not expected to experience any immediate impact from a potential partial government shutdown.
- Federal employee unemployment benefit filing guides have been reviewed and distributed to Workforce Center partners in preparation for a possible partial shutdown.
- Federal employees can file unemployment insurance claims online through self-service without needing to contact the Call Center.
- KDOL Unemployment Insurance phone lines will be closed on October 23 for an agency-wide in-service training day.

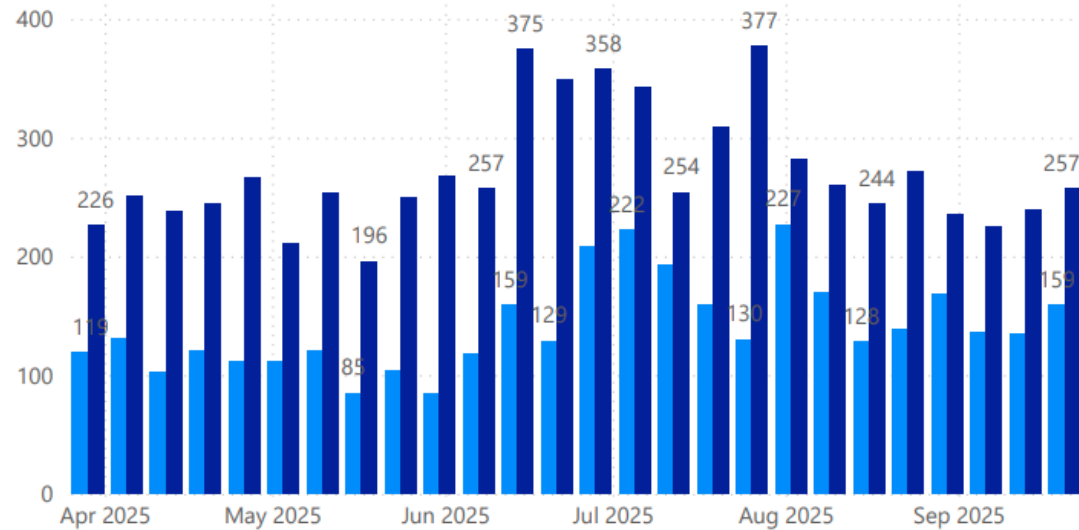

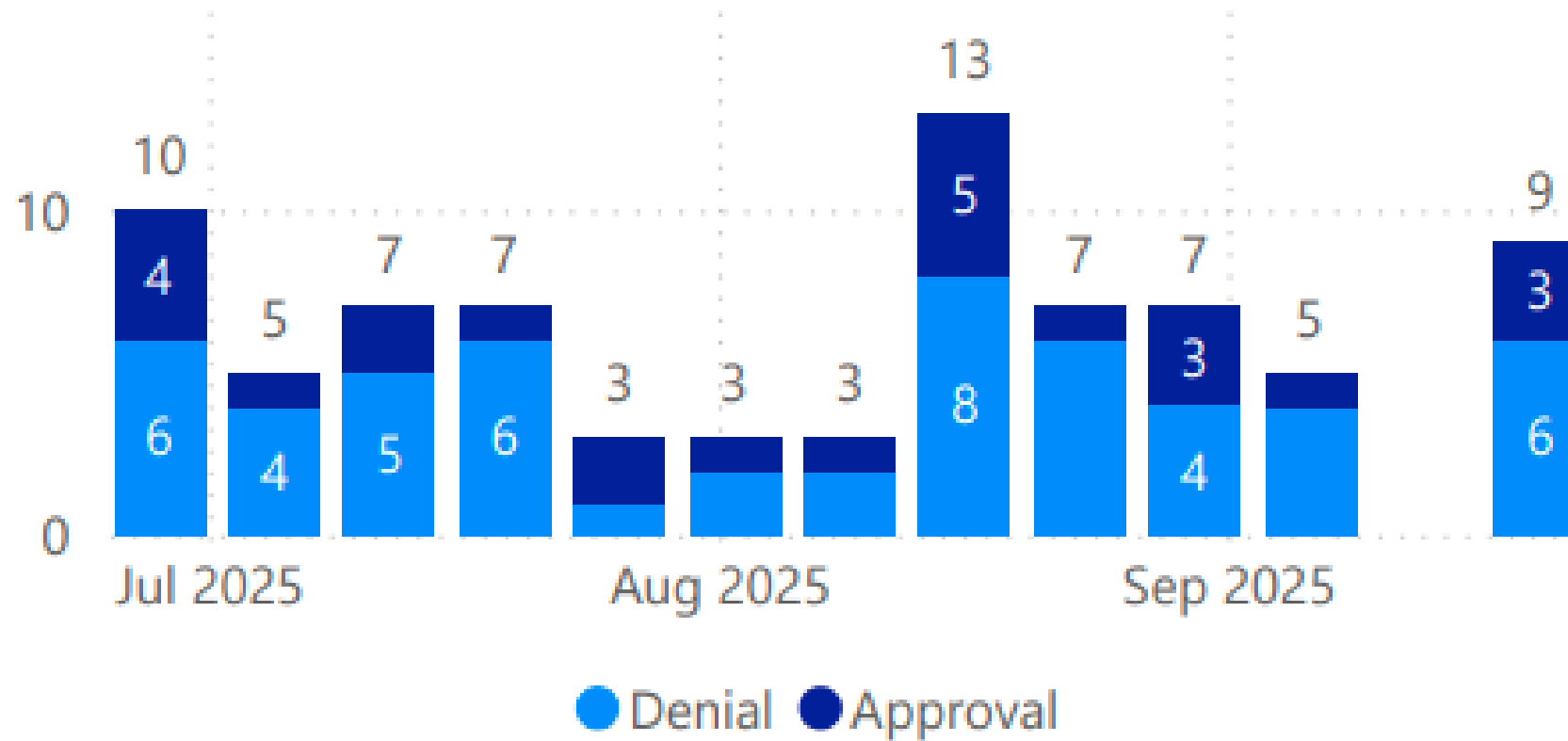

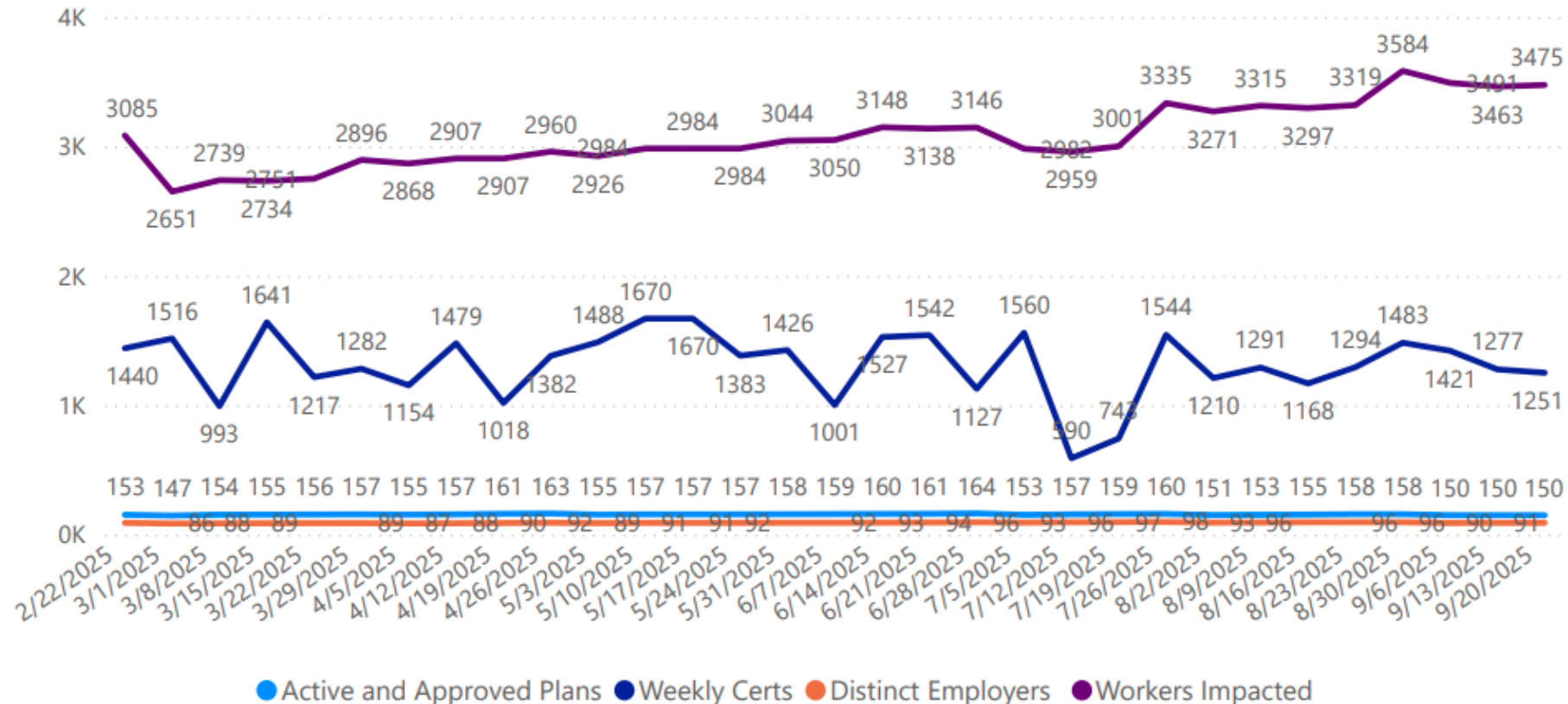

Q1: Jan. 1 thru March 31	April 30
Q2: April 1 thru June 30	July 31
Q3: July 1 thru Sept. 30	Oct. 31
Q4: Oct. 1 thru Dec. 31	Jan. 31

Employers are responsible for reporting and paying their taxes on time. KDOL does not send notifications for quarterly reports or payments due. Due dates that fall on a weekend or holiday will be due the following business day.
