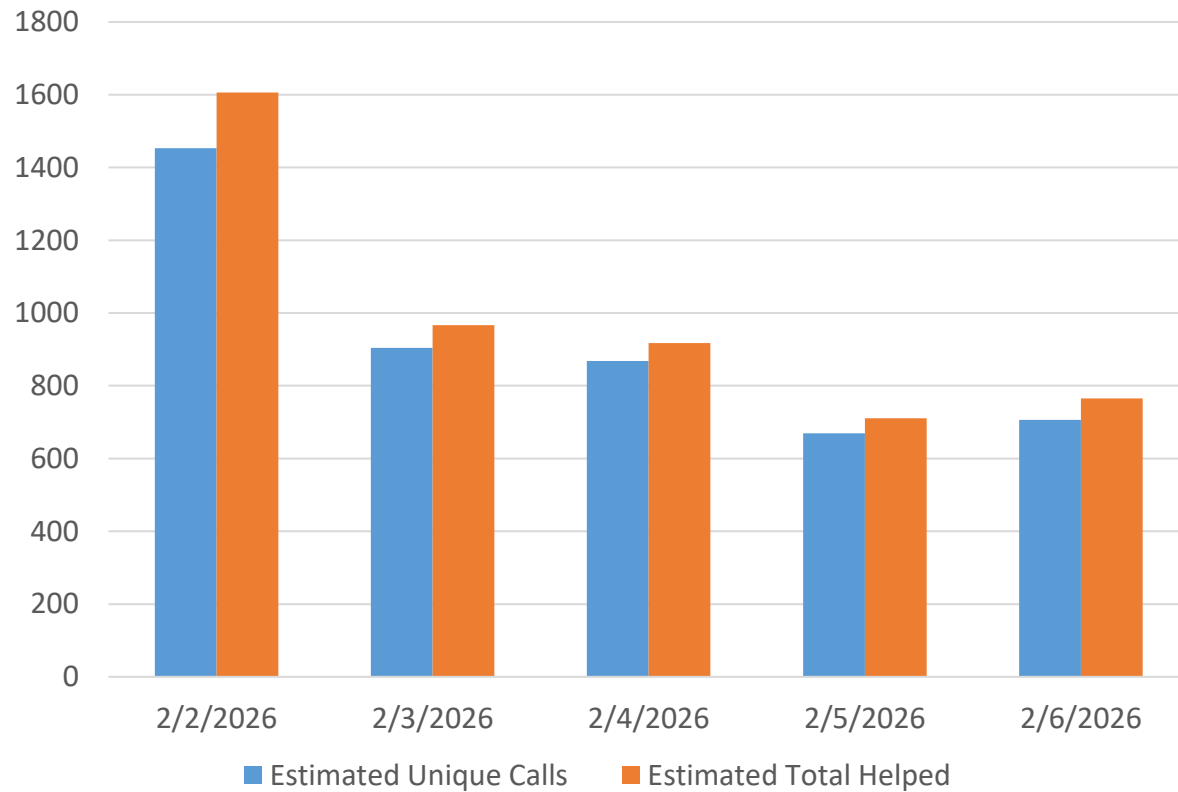

System Disruptions

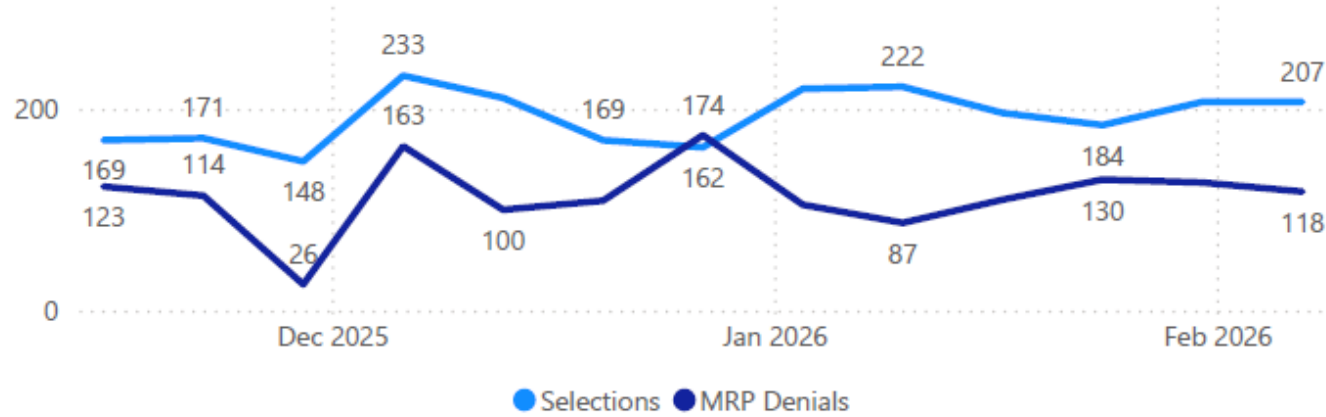
- February 3: A scheduled deployment to the UI claimant and employer portal was successfully completed.
 - The system was offline as planned from 6:00pm to 6:30pm.
- February 11: A scheduled deployment to the UI claimant and employer portal was successfully completed.
 - The system was offline as planned from 7:30pm to 9:00pm.
- March 11: A scheduled deployment to the UI claimant and employer portal is planned.
 - The system is expected to be offline from 7:30pm to 9:30pm.

Other

- Fourth quarter 2025 employer wage and tax reporting ran from January 1, 2026, through January 31, 2026, with no reported issues.
- KDOL UI Appeals met all USDOL standards for January 2026, marking the fifth consecutive month meeting USDOL metrics.
- KDOL UI 1099s for 2025 were delivered on time.
- The Unemployment Contact Center continued to answer 100% of estimated unique calls each day.

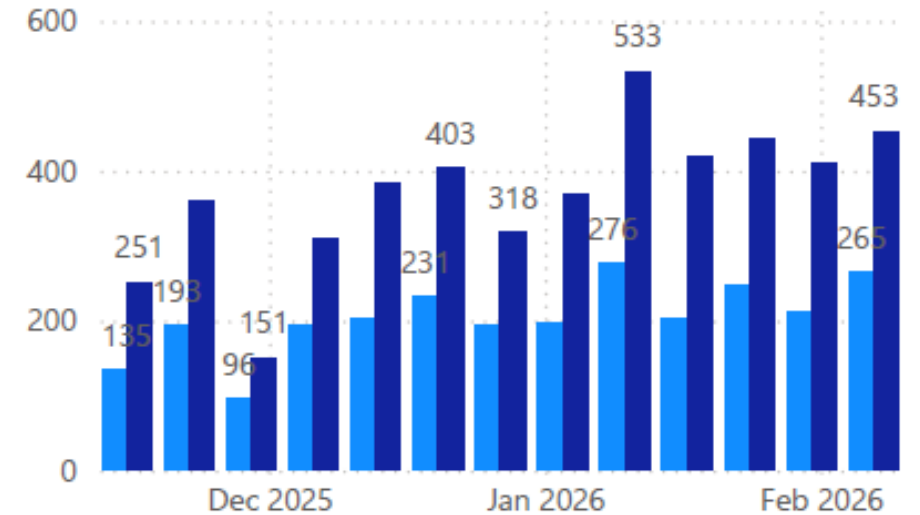

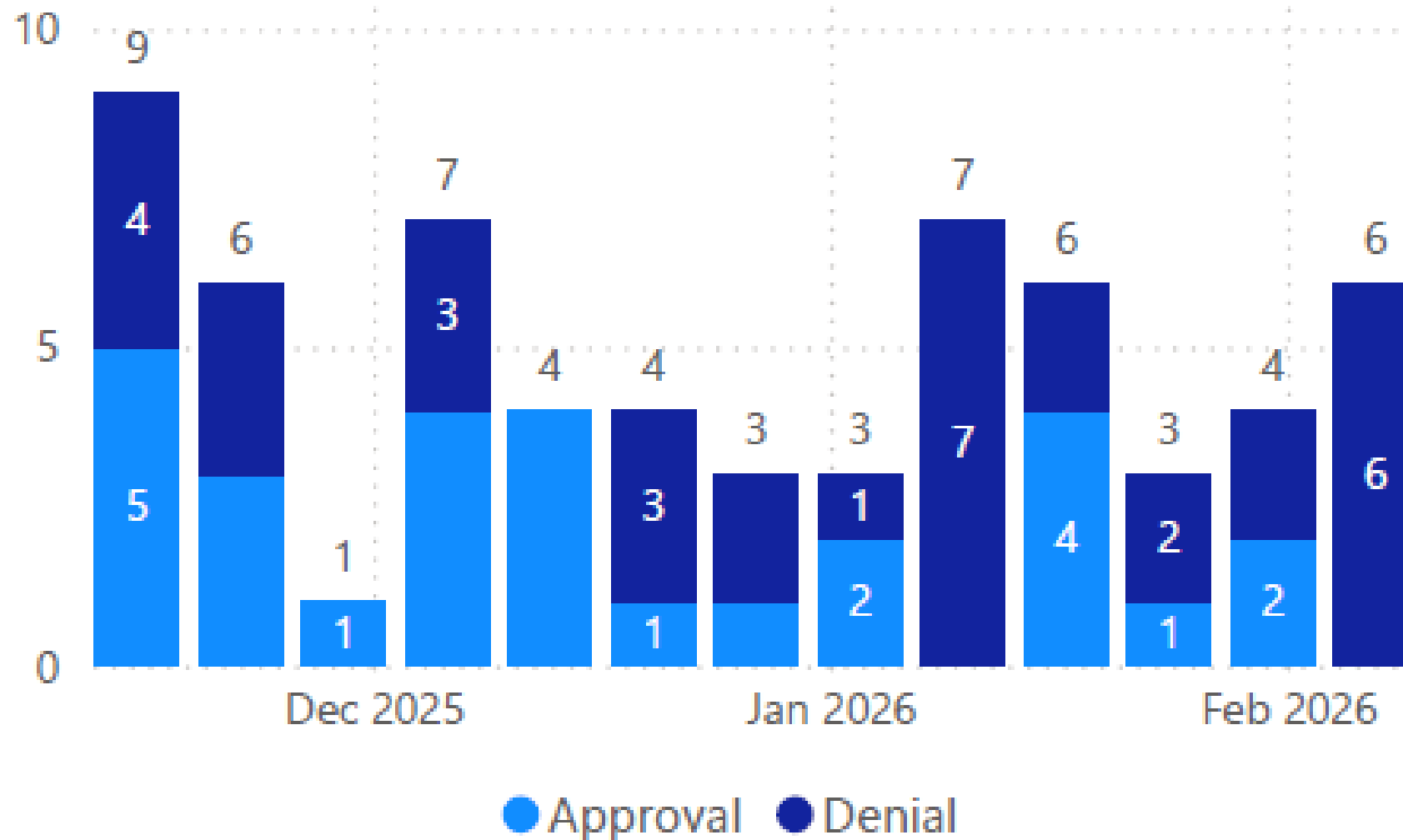

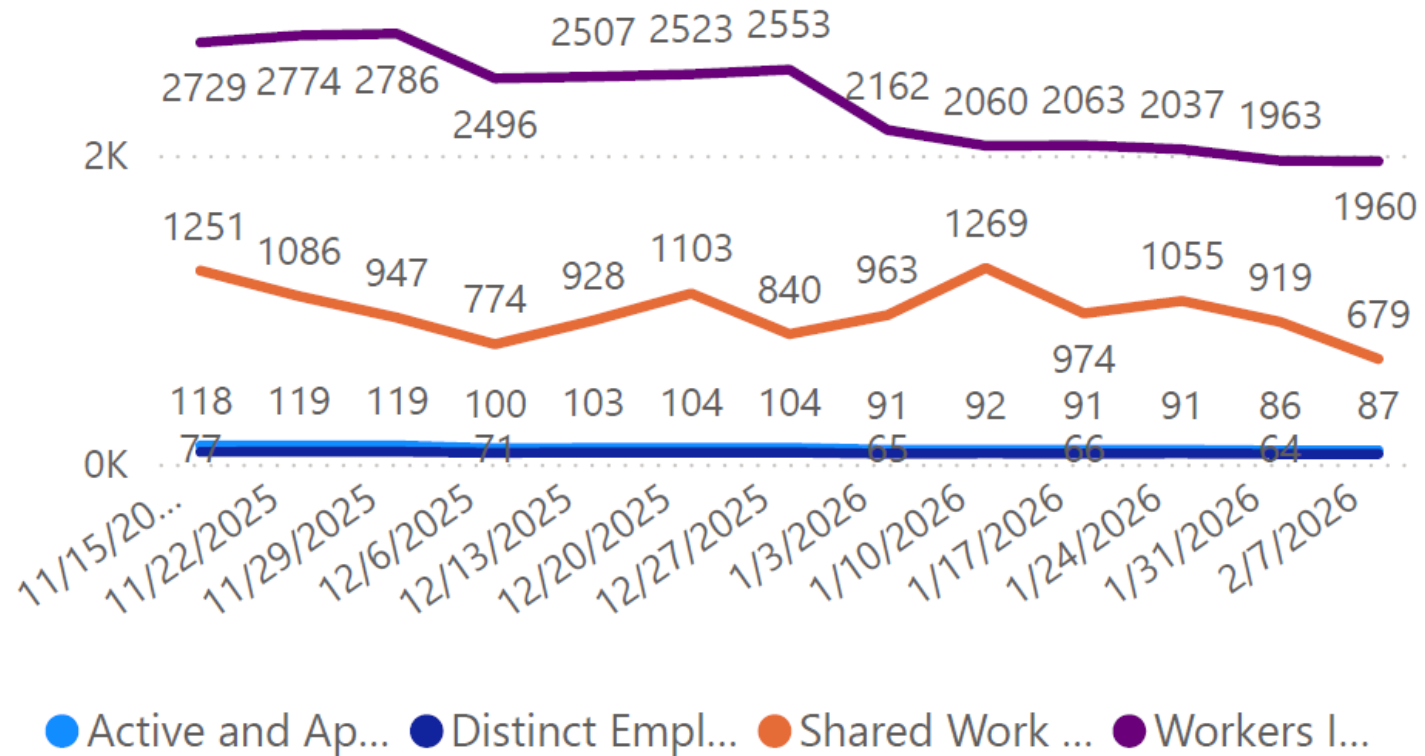
