- KAMPS replaces old ARPP program
- ARPP no longer works

Other Important Highlights

- It is **IMPERATIVE** that the serial number on your inspection and ASTM paperwork matches the serial number in the KAMPS system.
- It is also important that you have the correct entity type and ride type input in KAMPS so the fees are correctly calculated.
- **FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS WILL RESULT IN A DELAY IN PROCESSING AND ISSUING PERMIT(S).**

Insurance

- It is required that your entity name that is in KAMPS appear on your insurance. For example, your corporate name is ACME, Inc. and you do business as Bob's Inflatables. In KAMPS, the only information provided is Bob's Inflatables. If your insurance has Acme, Inc., we will not be able to accept it.
- If you have rides listed with serial numbers on your insurance, those serial numbers must match KAMPS.

Insurance Coverage Requirements

- Your entity type effects your insurance coverage requirements.
- Your entity may qualify as more than one entity type.
